Christopher Gillberg

je profesor otroške in mladostniške psihiatrije na Univerzi Gothenburg na Švedskem in zaslužni profesor na Inštitutu za zdravje otrok, University College London. Je tudi gostujoči profesor na Univerzi v Bergnu, New Yorku, Odense, na Univerzi St. George v Londonu, v San Franciscu, Glasgowu in Strathclydu. Z obsežnim raziskovanjem, ki obsega več kot 500 publikacij v bazi PubMed, je pomembno prispeval na strokovnem področju avtizma, motnje aktivnosti in pozornosti, epilepsije, duševne manjrazvitosti, vedenjskih motenj, sindroma Tourette in anoreksije nervoze. Je najbolj produktiven raziskovalec na področju avtizma na svetu. Njegovo raziskovanje zajema tako bazično nevroznanost, genetiko in epidemiologijo kot tudi klinično sliko, prognozo in terapevtske pristope. Je ustanovitelj in urednik European Child & Adolescent Psychiatry ter avtor in urednik številnih znanstvenih in strokovnih knjig, prevedenih v različne jezike. Za svoje odlično znanstveno in strokovno delo je prejel številne nagrade, ena najprestižnejših je nagrada za življenjsko delo s strani International Society of Autism Research (INSAR) v letošnjem letu.

Christopher Gillberg

is a professor of child and adolescent psychiatry at Gothenburg University in Sweden, and an honorary professor at the Institute of Child Health (ICH), University College London. He has also been a visiting professor at the universities of Bergen, New York, Odense, St George's (University of London), San Francisco, and Glasgow and Strathclyde. Christopher Gillberg's extensive research (more than 500 publications indexed on the PubMed data base), has significantly contributed to the field of child and adolescent neuropsychiatry/developmental medicine in areas such as autism spectrum disorders, ADHD, epilepsy, intellectual disability, oppositional defiant disorder/conduct disorder, Tourette syndrome and anorexia nervosa. He is the most productive researcher of autism in the world. His research ranges from basic neuroscience, genetics and epidemiology, through to clinical presentations and prognosis, intervention and treatment. He is the founding editor of the journal European Child & Adolescent Psychiatry, and is the author and editor of many scientific and educational books which have been published in a wide variety of languages. Professor Gillberg has received several awards for his research including the prestigious 2016 INSAR (International Society of Autism Research) Lifetime Achievement Award.
